Executive Summary

The present document constitutes the deliverable entitled “Reports on PA researchers, students, and farmers’ feedback” of the BOOST project, funded by the European Union through the European Education and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA). The main objective of BOOST is to empower students and farmers with theoretical and practical knowledge and tools to become agripreneurs in Precision Agriculture.
